Each event in the neighborhood was conducted with the elder's permission and timing, with no cost or waste. The situation was so aggravated that they were blamed for having a wedding and being in debt. Also, many people say, "It's hard to live," "When will we get rid of this ritual?" Indeed, we must strive to abandon the so-called Western culture.
