The department is part of the "Land Resources and Cadastre" faculty, and in 2017 it was separated from the previous "Geodesy and Land Cadastre" department. Looking at the history of the department, it was established in 2004 as a result of the merger of the previous "Geodesy" and "Land Cadastre" departments, and is one of the main specialized departments of the faculty. It should be noted that the "Geodesy" and "Land Cadastre" departments have their own rich history. The Department of "State Cadastres" was established in 1949 as one of the main specialized departments of the faculty under the name "Design and improvement of rural residential areas". From 1949 to 1982, Professor P.K.Tatur, "Honored land developer in Uzbekistan", d.e.s., who led it from 1949 to 1982, was invaluable in the establishment and comprehensive strengthening of the department. In 1982-1992, the department was headed by Associate Professor B.I.Sibizov, and in 1992-1999, it was headed by Associate Professor A.R. Bobojonov. In 2000-2004, the department was headed by Associate Professor I.M. Musayev, the professors who have worked and are working in it have made great contributions to the development and improvement of the department in the following years. They are d.e.s., professor A.S. Chertovskiy, d.e.s., V.V. Beshenov, d.e.s. associate professor K.R. Rahmonov, senior teacher T.I. Ismailov, associate professor They are the P.M. Kunyavskys. From 2004 to 2012, he was an associate professor at the department, Ph.D. I.M. Musayev was the leader. From 2012 to 2016, the department was headed by associate professor K. Rakhmanov. The Department of State Cadastres started its activities on September 2, 2017 after separating from the Department of Geodesy and Geoinformatics. In 2017-2023, the department will receive a Ph.D. led by associate professor K.R. Rahmonov. Since August 31, 2023, the department has been headed by Doctor of Philosophy, PhD, Associate Professor O'B. Mukhtorov. In addition to the training of highly qualified specialists, the team of the department focuses on the organization of rational and efficient use of land areas, land cadastre, management of land resources, which are the basis of the agrarian reforms implemented in our republic, as well as a high level of morale among students, focused on doing educational work. The relations of the department with related departments of higher educational institutions in foreign countries and in our republic, as well as with production and research and design organizations are being strengthened. In particular, the "Innovative and creative young cadastre" student

scientific circle has been operating in the department. 20 talented students work in the club. The team of the department participates in the exchange of experience of professors, teachers and students, international scientific projects, the creation of textbooks and training manuals on the basis of cooperation agreements with universities of similar fields in Finland, Latvia, Lithuania, Sweden, Great Britain, and Hungary. The scientists of the department regularly organize webinars and trainings and participate in master classes in returned foreign universities. 06.01.10 - The department has a doctoral program in the field of land surveying, cadastre and land monitoring. Among them, 2 doctoral students are defending their dissertations to obtain a PhD degree. Professors and teachers of the department have established strong relations with several scientific centers in the republic and abroad. In particular, scientific research is being carried out in cooperation with experts and professors of Karshi University of Engineering and Economics, National University of Uzbekistan, Tashkent State Technical University, Tashkent University of Architecture and Construction, as well as the International Center for Strategic Development and Research in the field of food and agriculture. At the same time, the creation of educational and methodological manuals has been started. Today, the department conducts direct production practice with the Cadastre Agency under the Ministry of Economy and Finance of the Republic of Uzbekistan and its local departments, departments, the Chamber of State Cadastres of the Cadastre Agency, the "Geoinnovation Center" DUK, the State Scientific Design Institute "Uzdaverloyiha", free after-school activities of students. Bilateral agreements have been drawn up on linking their time to production, organizing practical training within the framework of the 5+1 program, and organizing pre-graduation practice.
